## Analyzing Peace Processes

Project workshop at Goethe University Frankfurt, June 16-17, 2023

Submission deadline for abstracts: April 10, 2023

From Yemen to Ukraine and Mali to Myanmar, violent conflicts continue to rage in many countries across the globe. At the same time, adversaries come together, trying to end their fighting by reaching a negotiated settlement. In fact, since 1990, over 1800 agreements have been concluded in around 160 peace processes - some bring an end to years of conflict, while others represent only a small step in a long process or fail again all too quickly.

We are pleased to announce that we are hosting a workshop to discuss the latest research on this urgent topic. We invite papers applying theory-guided, empirical research to study conflict management and its effects on armed conflict. In particular, we encourage submissions exploring the conditions under which parties enter into talks, sign agreements, and whether negotiation results successfully contribute to pacification. We welcome contributions from researchers of all levels, junior and senior, as one of our goals is to promote the exchange and networking amongst researchers in the field.

The workshop will take place on the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of June, 2023 at Goethe University Frankfurt. We are grateful for funding from the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG, German Research Foundation) – Project No. 448508600, allowing us to cover accommodation and subsidize travel costs.
