

## Philosophy (Minor), Bachelor of Arts

### Start:

winter semester (beginning mid-October)

### Language Requirements:

German DSH Level 2, English

**Language of Instruction:** German (with rare exceptions)

### Duration:

3 years (6 semesters)

**Modules:** the course of study is segmented into modules. Typically modules consist of two courses and a final exam (taken in one of the courses).

**Types of modules:** BM (Basic Module), AM (Advanced Module), VM (Specialisation Module).

### Programme Details:

6 modules from the table below.

#### Core Requirements:

BM 1 and BM 2. BM 2 may be replaced by BM 3 Logic (philosophy major).

#### Electives:

Either three AM and one VM or two AM and two VM.

#### Admission Requirements for Modules:

In the above table, admission to a higher level module requires completion of all the modules below it. There may be additional requirements mentioned in the syllabus.

**ECTS Creditpoints:** 10 CP per module, 60 CP overall.

**Final Grade:**

the average of the best three modules.
