Chinatowns in Southeast Asia

Chinatowns are part of many city centers of Southeast Asia, especially seaports or riverine cities, where the population is predominantly of Chinese origin. These quarters are characterized by shophouses combining living and working space e.g. in Penang. During the colonial times, the urban space was shaped by the interaction between the colonial government and different Asian communities. In recent years, Chinatowns like in Singapore take on a role as historical and touristic centers.
