

## Refresh Your English Skills

### Objective

This three-session English language course provides an intensive review of the speaking, listening and writing skills on B1-C1 level needed to excel in academic English. By the end of the course, the student will feel more confident expressing his or her ideas in spoken or written English.

### Description

This refresher course provides students with ample practice in spoken and written English with the goal of improving fluency and grammatical expression. Through lively small group and class discussions, students practice their communication skills and gain confidence in spoken English. Listening comprehension practice includes English from various English-speaking countries. Students practice writing through short, in-class writing assignments with peer feedback; students are subsequently encouraged to review and revise their own writing (laptops are welcome in class, but are not required). English grammar is directly reviewed and practiced. The course also covers practical English skills such as telephoning, writing letters and making presentations.

The Workshop will take place at Campus Westend.

### Methodology

The primary teaching methodology of this workshop is the Communicative Language Teaching (CLT) approach, which emphasizes learning to communicate in the target language through interaction in a meaningful context. Task-Based Instruction (TBI) ensures that students practice the English skills needed in particular real-life situations.
