



Johanna-Quandt-Scholarship for participation at European Alpbach Forum from 18. August - 04. September 2021

The European Forum Alpbach is an interdisciplinary platform for science, politics, business and culture. Join smart minds from around the world in a charming Alpine village, immersing yourself in an environment bursting with novel ideas, new ways of thinking and opportunities for making great contacts.

This year, the Forum will take place from 18 August–3 September 2021. In any case, it will be a **hybrid conference** format but the degree of hybridity depends on the Corona situation. The Forum will take place under the general topic *"The Great Transformation"* and aims to answer some of the most pressing questions in times of unprecedented change.

For the fifth time the Goethe University sponsors the following Johanna-Quandt-Scholarships for the participation at the European Forum Alpbach:

- **Five full scholarships for the local participation** and the attendance present in Alpbach *(provided that the pandemic situation allows local attendance)*^{*I*}
- **Several partial scholarships for the digital participation** at the virtual European Forum Alpach

The full scholarships cover the participation fee for the whole duration of the event, as well as expenses for accommodation, subsistence and travel. The partial scholarships cover the participation fee for the virtual Forum.

Who can apply?

- Students and Doctoral Candidates from the Goethe University from all academic disciplines up to the age of 30.
- International students are highly encouraged to apply.

What do we expect?

- Interest in this year's general topic of the European Alpbach Forum "The Great Tranformation"
- Very good English Skills (minimum B2-Level)
- An open, critical and tolerant mindset, that is open for new perspectives
- Active participation at the seminars, lectures and workshops at the European Alpbach Forum
- Attendance at the programme before, during and after the European Alpbach Forum organized by the Goethe University

¹ The full scholarship for the participation and attendance on the spot in Alpbach can only be granted under reserve. If the pandemic situation does not allow a participation in Alpbach the scholarship will automatically be transferred to a partial scholarship for the digital participation at the virtual Forum.





How to apply and required documents?

- Completly filled out application form
- **Curriculum Vitae** (max. 1 page) *Note: CV should display your education, practical experience and extra-curricular activities*
- Transcript of Records or Bachelor-/Master Degree certificate
- **Evidence of your English proficiency** (minimum B2-level) for non-native speakers

Note: Evidence that you have reached European level B2, e.g. a confirmation by your school, employer or a university professor, explicitly stating that you have reached B2 or an equivalent to B2. If the document fails to proof that you have reached B2, we will not be able to consider it. We also accept language certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS

- Letters of acceptance and refusal will be sent out by mid July 2021
