

## German Intermediate Course - B1+

### Objective

To achieve language level B1+, the upper intermediate level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (GER).

### Description

This is the **third** and final module of the course B1, which begins with the two modules B1-1 and B1-2. After the completion of the B1+ course, you will be able to:

- Understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in your field of specialization
- Interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party
- Produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options
- Use grammatical structures: e.g. reported speech, indefinite pronouns, nominalisation of nouns

The textbook that will be used in the course will be announced in the first lesson.

At the end of the course, participants who participated in 80% of the course will receive a certificate of completion.

This course will take place online.

### Conditions

- Pre-requisite for this workshop is the successful participation in the B1-2 level course.
- Participants of GRADE's B1-2 courses will be given priority at registration.
- Registration is binding. The costs of 25,00 EUR have to be paid prior to the course and will not be reimbursed.
