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1. First Steps – Registering for the Degree Program

There is one final piece of paperwork you must take care of at the beginning of the master's program, in order to formally register with the degree certification department "Prüfungsamt Geistes- und Kulturwissenschaften" (PGK). You must fill out and sign the application for the master's exam admission, and send it to the PGK. This is necessary in order to receive grades and Credit Points within the degree program.

You can download the application by visiting the PGK website: www.pgks.de

Choose the download section and navigate to "American Studies, Master (ab WS 2017/18)". Select "Zulassung Masterprüfung" highlighted in blue on the left, below the title. This will prompt the download of the application form as a PDF.

Select "Ich möchte Ihnen eine oder mehrere Dateien senden" under "Worum geht es?", then select "American Studies" under "Mein Studiengang". Write "Application M.A. Exam Admission" under "Betreff" and write your message under "Nachricht". Don't forget to fill out your personal information at the top. Your message will then be sent to the PGK and you will receive a confirmation of your registration, usually within a few days.

Later, when you have completed all of your seminars and discussed your topic with your professor, you can download the application form for your master's thesis examination by clicking on the section "Anmeldung Master Arbeit" highlighted in blue on the bottom right below "American Studies, Master (ab WS 2017/18)". This form must then also be submitted to the PGK for confirmation.

The PGK has one member of staff that is responsible for the American Studies degree programs. Currently, this is Mrs. Daniela Simon (Nov. 2020). She can be reached by phone (069-798-23637), per e-mail (d.simon@em.uni-frankfurt.de), or simply through the PGK's contact page.

Remember: There is a deadline for the submission of the application several weeks after the beginning of the winter term. Make sure to complete your application in a timely manner, and check the PGK website for further information.

You can also download transcript forms ("Modulscheine") from the PGK's website. You will need them when you submit a term paper, and for your "Akademisches Optionalmodul". These transcripts serve as a record of the seminars and modules you have completed. Your grades will be available online (see p. 8), however you can submit your Modulschein in case your grade should not appear. The only Modulschein you will have to submit is the one for the "Akademisches Optionalmodul", as this information is not automatically sent to the PGK. In case you have any questions regarding your Akademisches Optionalmodul, feel free to contact Prof. Simon Wendt (wendt@em.uni-frankfurt.de), who is currently the head of the master's degree program.



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

In order to **register for exams**, select "Register for Exams" under "Administration of exams. Read the terms of agreement and click "I accept". Then you will be prompted to enter one of the numbers from your ITAN list. If you have misplaced your list, contact the HRZ. The ITAN serves as a

confirmation code for your exam registration. After entering it, you can select the exam you wish to register for.

Remember: You must register for every exam you take, whether it is a test or a term paper. Make sure to inform yourself on when the registration deadlines are, your instructors should be able to tell you when they are. If you do not register, you will not be able to submit a term paper or take the test.







American Studies Department / Amerikanistik

Die Amerikanistik des IEAS ist nach dem John F. Kennedy-Institut für Nordamerikastudien an der FU Berlin die größte in der Bundesrepublik Deutschland und gehört zusammen mit den Instituten in Berlin und München zu den ältesten und einzigen interdisziplinär ausgerichteten Amerikanistik-Abteilungen in Deutschland.

Seit der Gründung vor über fünfzig Jahren wird in der Frankfurter Amerikanistik der Gegenstand Nordamerika interdisziplinär mit den drei gleichwertigen Schwerpunkten Literaturwissenschaft, Kulturwissenschaft, Geschichte und Gesellschaft gelehrt und erforscht.

Die Forschung und das Lehrangebot innerhalb der drei Schwerpunkte umfassen ein weites Spektrum von Erkenntnisinteressen, theoretischen Ansätzen und intellektuellen Traditionen. Sie schließen amerikanische Geschichte, African-American Studies, Popular Culture, Animal Studies, Gender und Queer Studies, Medientheorie und Medienphilosophie, sowie politische Theorie und Ästhetik mit ein. Das Studium vermittelt Wissen über die soziale, politische, kulturelle und literarische Geschichte der USA mit Blick auf gegenwärtige Entwicklungen und transkulturelle Kontexte. Studentinnen und Studentinnen haben damit die Möglichkeit, sich mit der Vielfalt der amerikanischen Erfahrung auseinanderzusetzen, wie sie in literarischen und nicht-literarischen kulturellen Formen Ausdruck findet.

Der Schwerpunkt Literaturwissenschaft vermittelt Kenntnisse in der Literaturgeschichte Nordamerikas von der Kolonialzeit bis zur Gegenwart und in Literaturtheorie. Er lehrt Methoden der Analyse und Interpretation literarischer Texte unter Berücksichtigung ihrer ästhetischen Eigenheiten und ihrer historischen und sozialen Kontexte. Unsere Seminare machen Studentinnen und Studentinnen außerdem mit einer Fülle unterschiedlicher literarischer Genres und Formen vertraut.

Im Schwerpunkt Kulturwissenschaft lernen Studierende nicht-literarische kulturelle Objekte (etwa Film, Musik und andere popkulturelle Formen) in Zusammenhang mit größeren kulturellen Mustern zu analysieren. Zu den Besonderheiten der Frankfurter Amerikanistik gehört ein starker Fokus auf Medien und Medialität und ein großes Angebot an Seminaren, die Studierende mit medientheoretischen und medienphilosophischen Ansätzen vertraut machen. Ein weiteres Augenmerk liegt auf den Querverbindungen zwischen Politik und Ästhetik im Hinblick auf den Wandel der amerikanischen Öffentlichkeit.

Im Rahmen des Schwerpunkts amerikanische Geschichte und Gesellschaft werden gesellschaftliche und politische Entwicklungen in den USA mit den Methoden der Sozial-, Politik- und Kulturgeschichte unter Einbindung historischer Quellen erforscht. Besonderes Gewicht liegt hierbei auf afroamerikanischer Geschichte. Unser American Studies-Programm ist eines von lediglich drei
