The Editors' Perspective

Objective

Getting acquainted with the publication procedure of high level journals.

Description

Prof. Dr. Joachim Curtius is an editor of Atmospheric Chemistry and Physics, which publishes papers focusing on atmospheric research and related disciplines. He will introduce the editors' and reviewers' perspective and explain the rules for the acceptance of a manuscript.

He will give an overview on open access publishing and on transparency of the review process.

The online workshop will also include an introduction to the submission procedures, the role of the cover letter and on the review process.

Important aspects of scientific writing, as well as authorship rules/order of author lists, and good scientific practice for publishing will be discussed.

Participants will have the chance to ask special questions in the plenum.
