Professorship (W2 with tenure track) for Cardiovascular Regeneration

The CPI is a joint research institute of the Goethe University Frankfurt, the Justus Liebig University Giessen and the Max Planck Society, supported by the German Cluster of Excellence Strategy Program. The CPI strives to make groundbreaking contributions to cardiopulmonary science with the long-term goal of reducing morbidity and mortality in cardiopulmonary diseases.

We are looking for a personality with an outstanding track record in cardiovascular research and specifically in the areas of regeneration, repair, anti-aging and rejuvenation. The acquisition of extramural funding and leadership experience is mandatory. A tight interaction with the other groups within the center is expected. The professorship will be located at the European Cardiovascular Science Center at the University of Frankfurt and will have full access to all core-facilities within the CPI including next generation sequencing, proteomics, bioinformatics, cytometry, microscopy and small animal imaging.

Requirements for applications are a university degree, teaching experience, a doctorate, a habilitation or proof of equivalent scientific achievements, which may also have been achieved as part of a junior professorship or at a non-university institution.

The formal hiring requirements are defined in sections 67, 68 and 70 of the Hessian Higher Education Act (Hessisches Hochschulgesetz).
