

German Advanced Course - C1-1

Objective

To achieve language level C1, the advanced level of proficiency according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF). The aim of this learning stage is the ability to express oneself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions.

Description

This is the **first** part of the course C1, which we offer in **two** modules: C1-1 and C 1-2. After the completion of **both** modules, i.e. the full C1 course, you will be able to:

- use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes,
- understand a wide range of demanding, longer clauses, and recognize implicit meaning ,
- produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organizational patterns, connectors and cohesive devices.
