To achieve language level C1, the advanced level of proficiency according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF). The aim of this learning stage is the ability to express oneself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions.

### Description

This is the **second** part of the course C1, which we offer in **two** modules: C1-1 and C 1-2. After the completion of **both** modules, i.e. the full C1 course, you will be able to:

- express ideas fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions,
- recognise a wide range of idiomatic expressions and colloquialisms, appreciating register shifts,
- follow most lectures, discussions and debates with relative ease.
