Objective

To achieve language level B2, the upper intermediate level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF).

Description

This is the **first** part of the course B2, which we offer in three modules: B2-1, B2-2, and B2-3. After the completion of **all modules**, i.e. the full B2 course, you will be able to:

- understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in your field of specialization,
- interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party,
- produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options,
- use grammatical structures: e.g. reported speech, indefinite pronouns, nominalisation of nouns.

At the end of the course, participants who participated in 80% of the course will receive a certificate of completion.
