Description

This hands-on online workshop explores the perspectives of developing a sustainable career in research and how to mitigate potential risks.

It also provides essential guidance on exploiting research funding opportunities effectively at the early to advanced postdoctoral stage.

Participants will learn how to

- employ key strategy tools to develop their research agenda,
- identify a portfolio of funding opportunities to pursue in the coming years,
- manage the grant life cycle systematically to build their resources and capabilities for further career advancement.

Taking an international perspective, the workshop helps to assess the current position, to review career aspirations as well as longer-term research goals and to develop a road map for achieving them in the individual setting.

This highly interactive workshop employs theoretical input, plenary discussions, individual and small group work, experience sharing and expert advice.
