

International Liaison Fellowships 2024

Goethe University and Johanna Quandt Young Academy @Goethe (JQYA) are offering fellowships to foster interdisciplinary and international scientific exchange and network in 2024.

The JQYA provides a platform for interdisciplinary discourse among outstanding early career researchers. It not only supports researchers financially, but offers diverse opportunities to develop and contour their unique, independent academic profile in a global context. By facilitating freedom for scientific research, the Young Academy significantly supports effective career development in the R3 phase, bundles scientific potential for future academic leadership and contributes to the (further) development of excellence at Goethe University.

We intend to inspire outstanding researchers of Goethe University with an established international reputation to join the academy as Associated Fellows. In particular, we address junior research group leaders and advanced postdocs who have been awarded highly competitive third party funding and who have just established or are considering establishing their own research group at Goethe University.

Application deadlines: 31.01. and 15.07.2024

Funding: Grants, up to \leq 5 000 each, provided indirectly by the German Research Foundation (DFG), as reimbursement upon receipt by Nov. 1, 2024 for: travel expenses (no conference fees), project-specific consumables, research inventory (low-value goods up to \leq 600), organisation of international workshops at/in collaboration with Goethe University (travel costs and honorariums for guest speakers) or resulting Open Access publications with external cooperation partners

Applicants: Associated Fellows of JQYA, as well as other postdocs and junior research group leaders (advanced R2 and R3) of Goethe University
