





Ulrich Breuer, born 1961, studied physics at RWTH Aachen University, where he received his doctorate (Dr. rer. nat.) in 1991. From 1991 to 2005, Ulrich Breuer held various positions with power of attorney at Forschungszentrum Jülich. In 2005, he moved from Forschungszentrum Jülich to the Hahn-Meitner-Institute Berlin, where he served as commercial director. From 2009 to 2011, Ulrich Breuer worked as commercial director of the Helmholtz-Zentrum Berlin für Materialien und Energie, which resulted from the merger between the Hahn-Meitner-Institute and BESSY (Berlin Electron Storage Ring Society for Synchrotron Radiation). From 2012 to 2017, he served as vice president economics and finance at Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT). In 2018, Ulrich Breuer became commercial director at Helmholtz-Zentrum Dresden-Rossendorf (HZDR), a position he held until 2020. From 2020 to 2023, he served as administrative managing director of GSI Helmholtzzentrum für Schwerionenforschung GmbH and FAIR – Facility for Antiproton and Ion Research in Europe GmbH in Darmstadt. For many years, Ulrich Breuer has successfully managed his professional environment by taking on the perspectives of both businessman and science manager.

Since July 1, 2023 Ulrich Breuer is Head of administration and member of the executive board at Goethe University Frankfurt.
