

German Elementary Course - A 1-1

Objective

To master the first part of language level A 1, the lowest level of proficiency according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF). The aim of this learning stage is the ability of a basic language use that is fundamental for further language learning.

Description

This is the **first** part of the course A 1, which we offer in two modules: A A1-1 and A 1-2. After the completion of **both modules** i.e. the full A 1 course, you will be able to:

- understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type
- introduce yourself and others, ask and answer questions about personal details such as where you live, people you know and things you have
- interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help
- use basic grammatical structures.: e.g articles, declension of nouns, personal pronouns and prepositions

At the end of the course, participants who participated in 80% of the course will receive a certificate of completion.
