Objective

Description

Presenting posters at scientific conferences is one of the key points in every scientist's academic career and an opportunity to get in touch with experts of one's research field. In this workshop, you will learn about the different aspects of a successful poster presentation and (virtual) conference attendance.

Methodology

This workshop consists of 3x 2,5 hours real-time webinars spread over a few days. Between the webinars you spend time on our online learning platform which contains movies, eBooks, podcasts and exercises (with instructor- and peer-to-peer- feedback). Adding all up, it takes you 14-16 hours to complete the course.
