### Objective

To achieve language level B2, the upper intermediate level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF).

### Description

This is the **first** part of the course B2, which we offer in two modules: B2-1 and B2-2. After the completion of **both modules**, i.e. the full B2 course, you will be able to:

- Understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in your field of specialization
- Interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party
- Produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options
- Use grammatical structures: e.g. reported speech, indefinite pronouns, nominalisation of nouns

The textbook used in the course will be *Aspekte neu B2*, ISBN: 978-3-12-605027-2.

At the end of the course, participants who participated in 80% of the course will receive a certificate of completion.

We will inform you in a timely manner whether the course will take place online or at Campus Westend.

- Pre-requisite for this workshop is the successful participation in the complete B1 level course.
- Participants of GRADE's B1 course will be given priority at registration.
- Registration is binding. The costs of 25,00 EUR have to be paid prior to the course and will not be reimbursed.
