

## Editor's Perspective: Focus on Life Sciences

### Objective

To understand the submission, review and publication process and therefore to increase the chances of getting your manuscript accepted

### Description

During this online workshop, you will get

- an introduction to the submission and review process,
- key points editors watch out for,
- an idea on how to define "quality",
- an idea about pro and cons of impact factors,
- knowledge on publication costs: open access vs. subscription models.

The editorial processes of journals will be presented, providing an overview of how to choose the correct journal to fit your manuscript, key points that editors look for and the review process. This will incorporate tips for getting your manuscript into peer review, selection of reviewers and key points to check your manuscript for. Furthermore, strategies to quantify scientific quality and impact of publications will be discussed in general.

Moreover, differences between purely open-access journals and more traditional journals (subscription model) will be presented.
